The "Ceres" issue was the first series of imperforated postage stamps of France issued in 1849 the series bore the image of Ceres, Goddess of growing plants in Roman Mythology, Jacques -Jean Barre did the initial design and drawing and gravure. Anotole Hulot was in charge of the printing of the Ceres series carried out in Paris in the 19th century. The drawing was used again by necessity when the Second Empire fell in 1870, two new series were issued in the 1930s and 1940s. These first issues earned philatelic interest because the black cancellations can be easily Masked and the 20c black issue could easily be re-used. The 40 Centimes blue in January was canceled and switched to orange. In December 1849 part of the paler red of the 1 franc stamps were recalled by the postal administration because the color was too close to the 40c orange to be issued in February 1850. The much lighter stamps were named "vermillion" by philatelists

Charles Louis- Napoleon Bonaparte 1808-1873. was the first President of the French Republic and ruler of the Second French Empire He was the nephew and heir of Napoleon 1 Napoleon 111 is primarily remembered for an energetic foreign policy which jettisoned the limitations imposed on France since 1815 by the concert of Europe and reasserted French influence in Europe and the French Colonial Empire. Napoleon stood opposed to the reactionary policies imposed at Vienna in 1815 and instead was an exponent of popular sovereignty, and a supporter of nationalism (1) Domestically, Napoleon's reign coincided with an era of prosperity and industrialization.

He launched a major reconstruction of Paris, conducted by Baron Haussmann, his prefect of the Seine, building new aqueducts, rebuilding the sewers, creating new boulevards and avenues, Park Montsouris and the Parc des Buttes-Chaumont. BALLON POST [BALLON MONTÉ]



During the siege of Paris in the Franco-Prussian War, mail and newspapers were carried by balloons which are of great interest to philatelists. Sixty-five unguided mail balloons were released in besieged Paris to communicate with the world beyond the besieging forces, of which only two went missing. The world's first balloon airmail service was begun out of pure necessity and carried out by the brave acts and audacity of some of France's greatest scientists, inventors and artists. From the first announcement of the impending arrival of Prussian uhlans at the city gates, Parisians refused to capitulate. Instead the city rallied around the formation of a new Republic and began to work out valiant replies to the question of keeping advancing armies at bay. Even after the last trains had left the stations, carefully hidden telegraph cables and foot messengers were used to pass vital information through enemy lines. However, as an invincible iron circle closed in around the city, cleverly buried wires were cut and messengers captured, shot or turned back. At last, only the skies above the city remained open. The French term balloon monte means the balloon was manned whilst balloon non monte was unmanned. Balloon mail was also sent from Przmysl, Poland during World War I.

The Ceres issue was the first series of postage stamps for France issued in 1849. It bore the profile of Ceres, the Goddess of growing plants in Roman Mythology. Jacques-Jean Barre did the initial design and drawing and gravure. Anatole Hulot was in charge of the printing of the Ceres series carried out in Paris in the 19th century. The drawing was used again by necessity when the second Empire fell in 1870, two new series were issued in the 1930s and 1940s.
