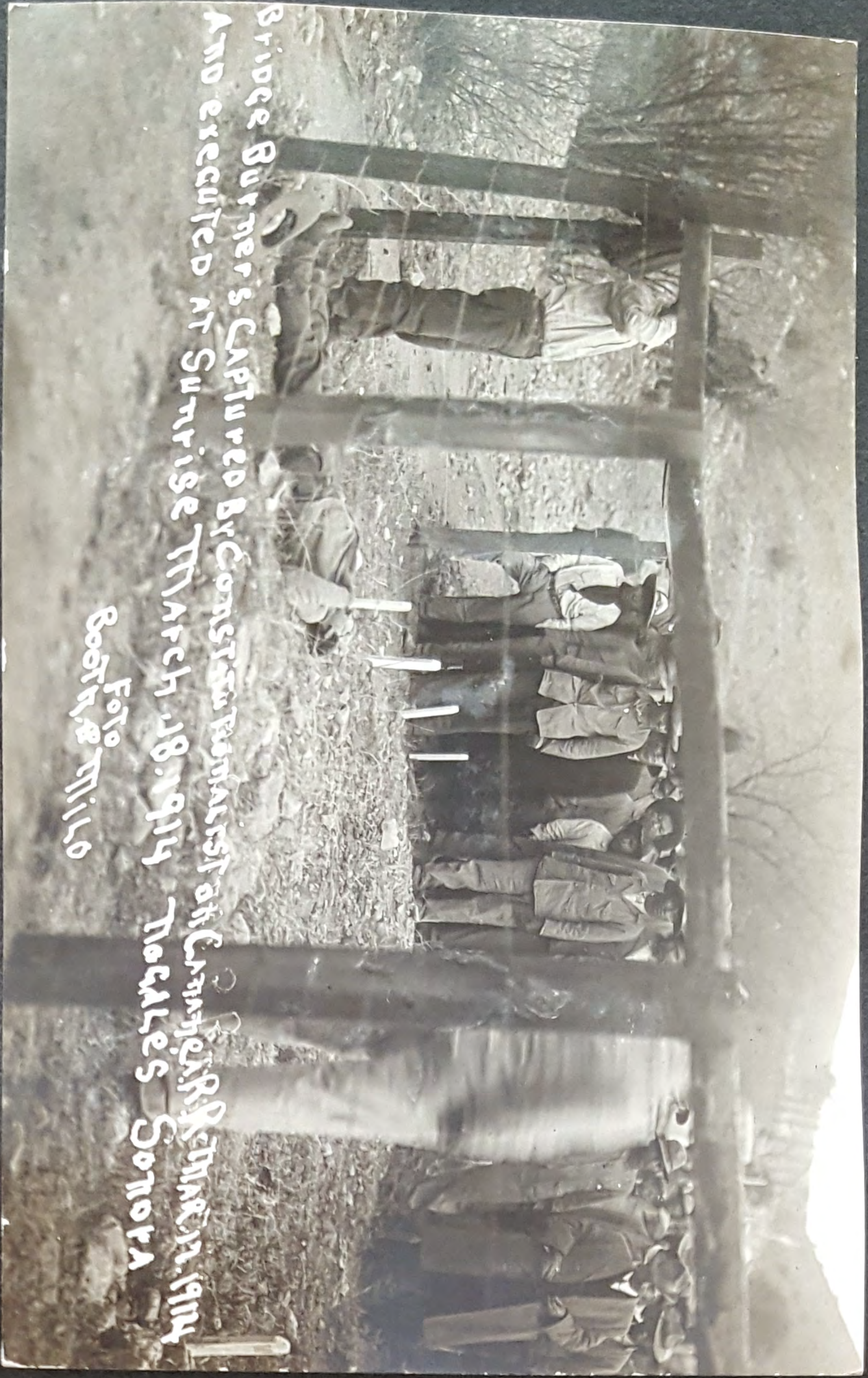








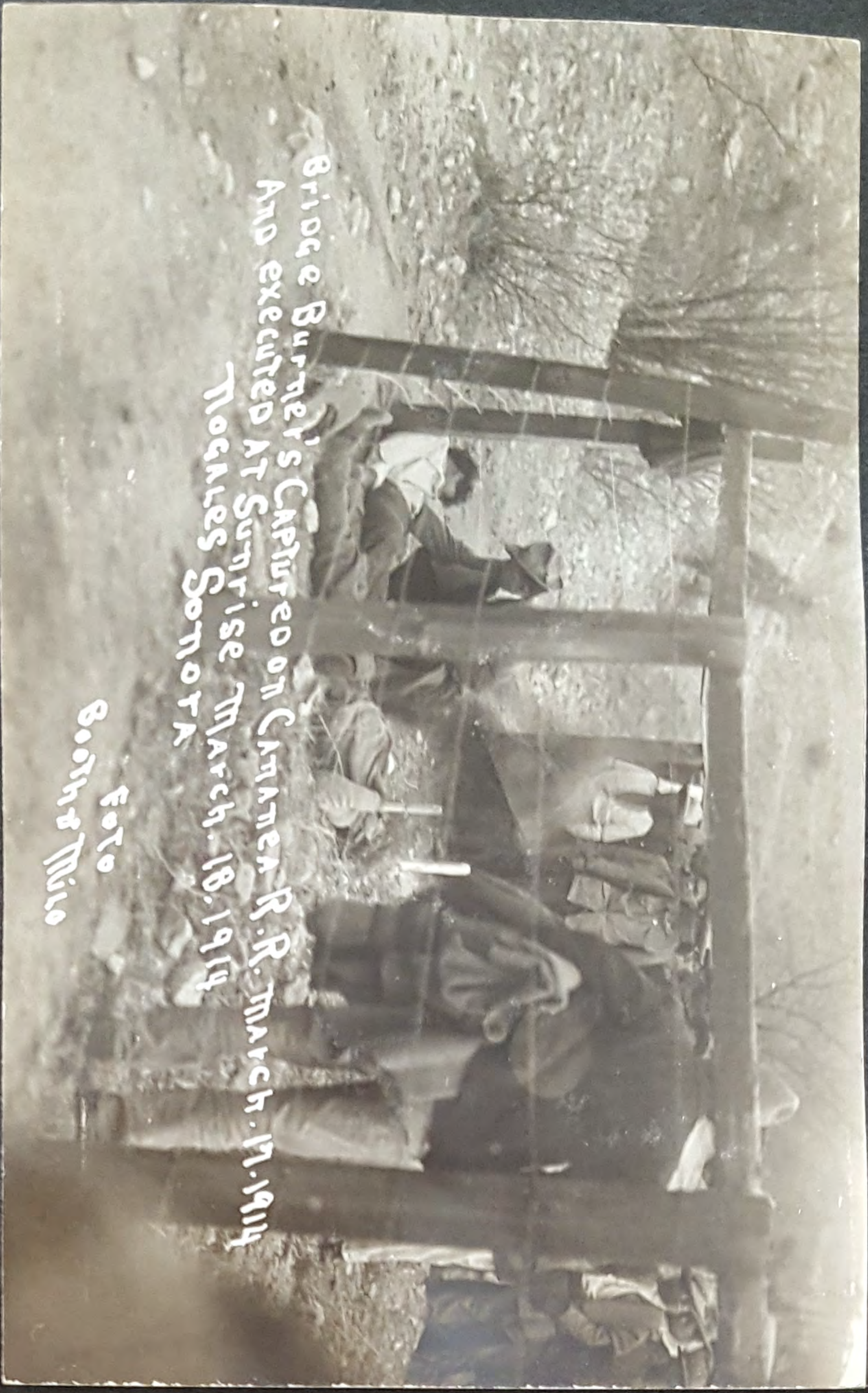




Bridge Burnett's Captured by Const. in Punishment of Carrizal, R. R. March 17, 1914

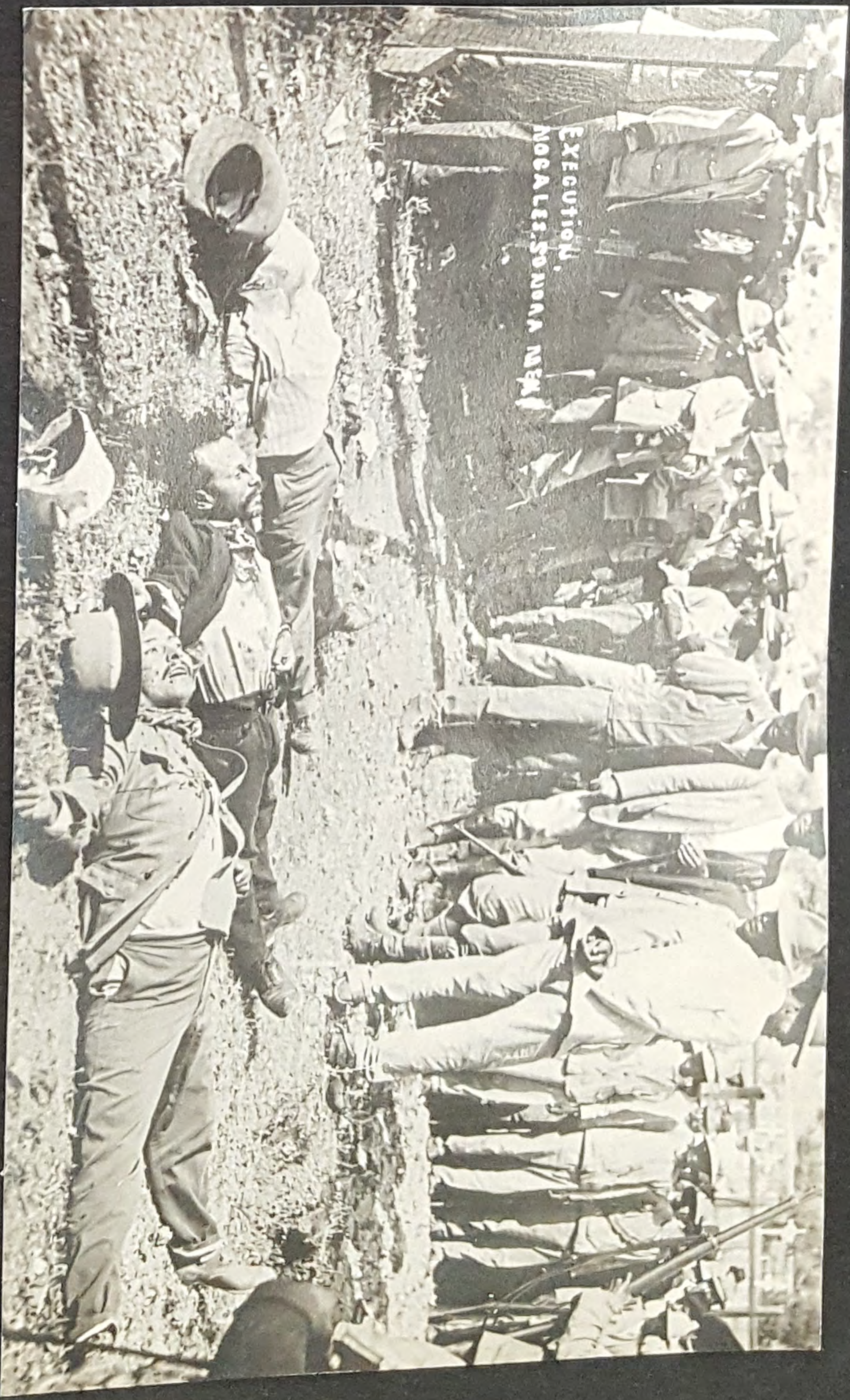


Bridge Burnett's Captured on the Carrizal R. R. March 17, 1914

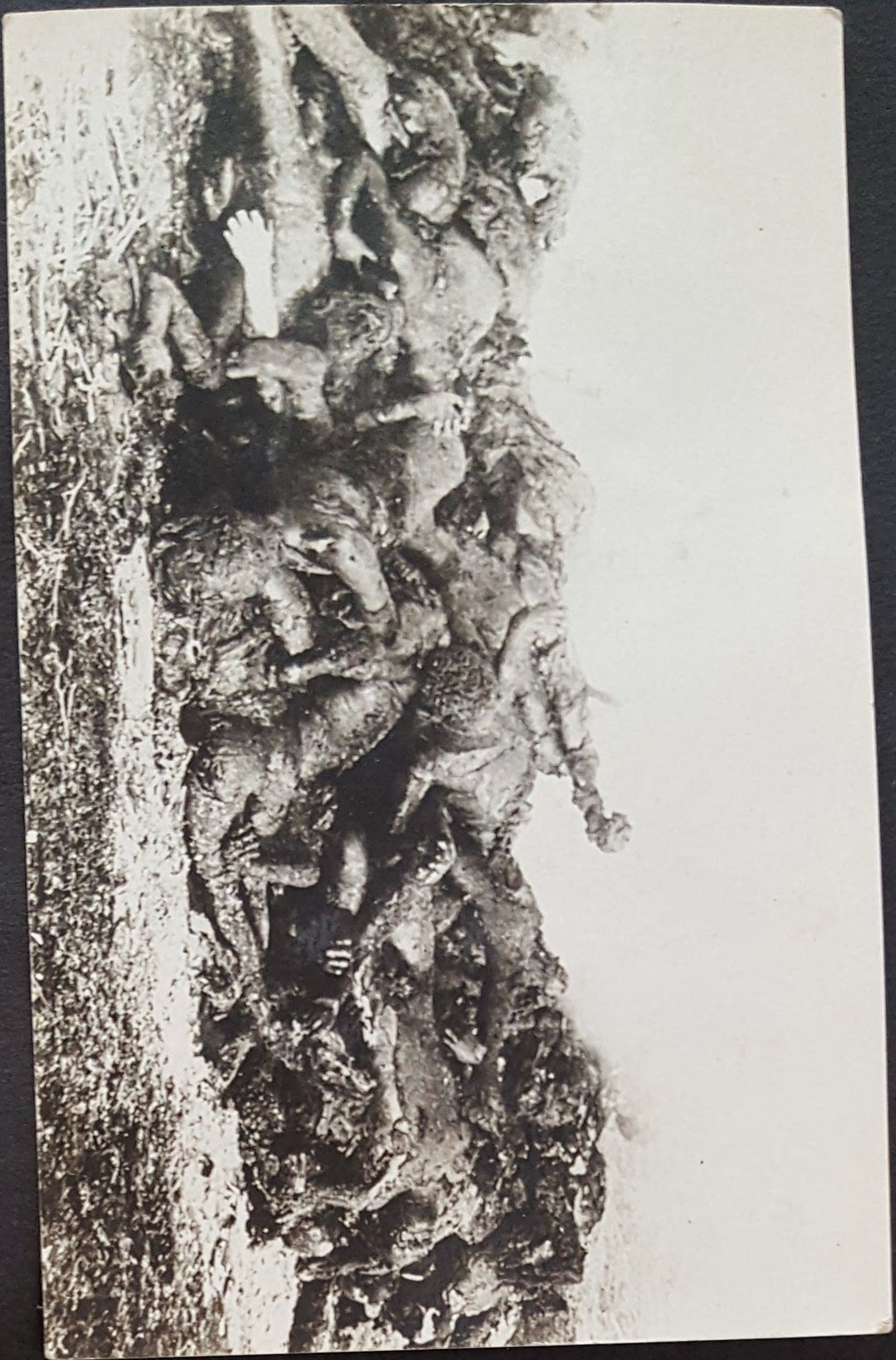


Bridge Burnett's Captured on Camino R.R. March 17, 1914

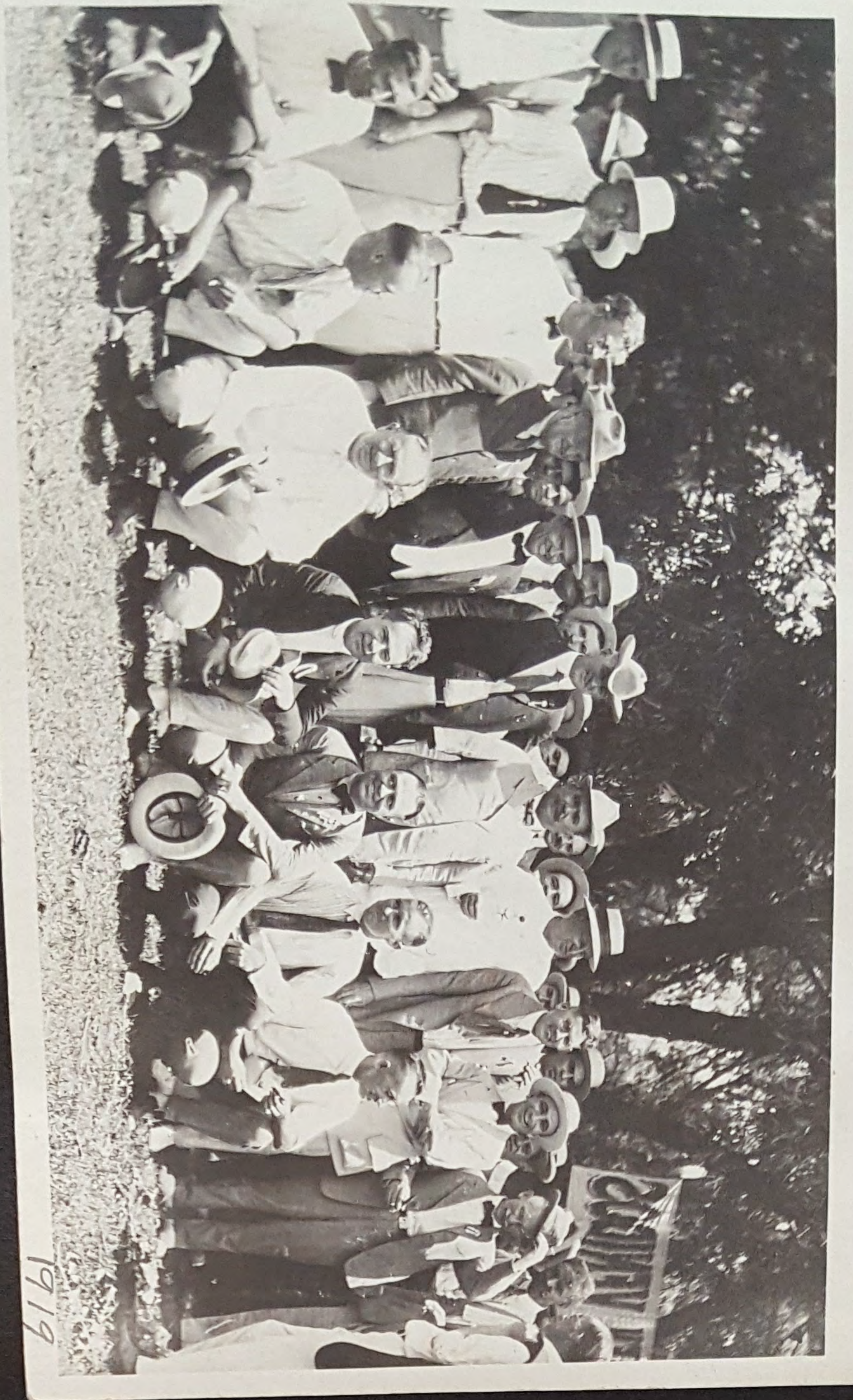




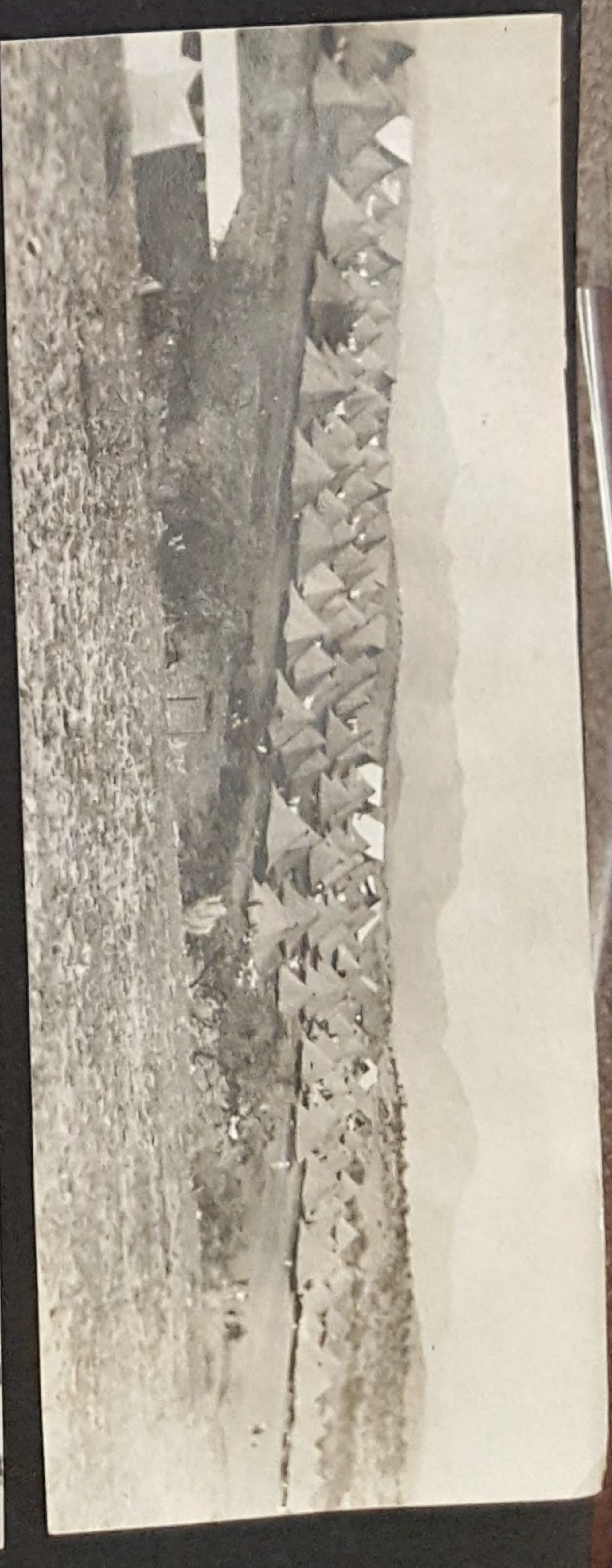

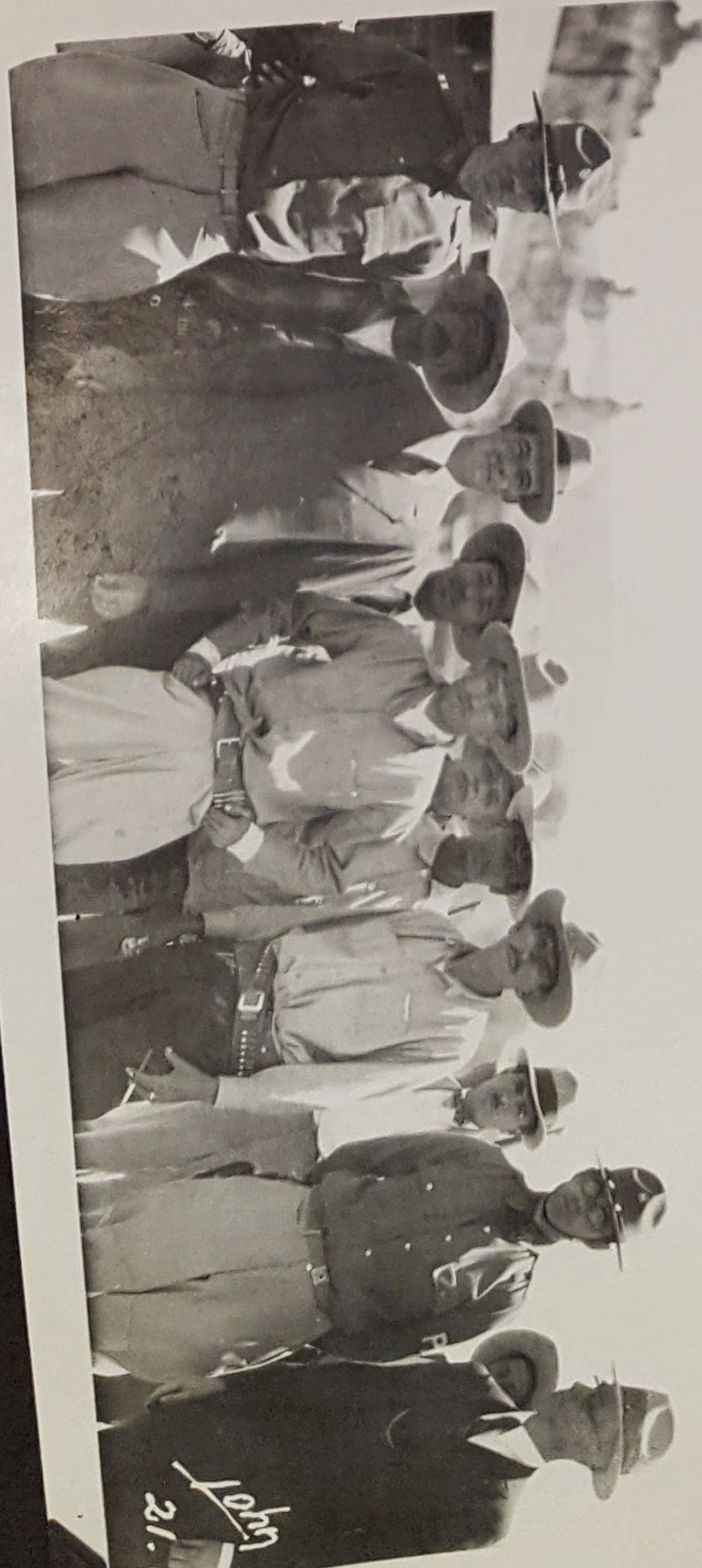
